An 80 proof bottle of clear spirits is 60% water. Water matters.

Spring44 is inspired by a natural spring located on the 11,000' East White Pine Mountain in Colorado's Buckhorn Canyon.

The 40 acres of private property are remote, and have the distinction of being surrounded by 160,000 acres of National Forest.



We harvest the water at the spring and haul it to the distillery in large tanks. The 3 ½ mile trek to the spring from the mountain's base is 2,000 feet in elevation gain. Meet Tinkerbell.

**Palate:** Nicely dry up front with an essence of grain. An amazing creaminess with a velvety texture and depth on the mid palate. Finish is long with a rye spiciness.

## SPRING44 HONEY VODKA

Appearance: Light golden in color with great clarity.

**Aroma:** Aromas of lavender and fresh honey straight from the honeycomb. Hints of vanilla and toasted nuts.

**Palate:** Light honey sweetness up front with floral notes, hints of lavender. Mid palate is creamy with warm vanilla and rich honey. Finish is long with notes of toasted nuts.

# SPRING44 GIN

Appearance: Shiny with impeccable clarity

Aroma: Initially floral, with notes of lemon zest giving way to juniper spiciness.

**Palate:** Delightfully citrus on the front palate with lemon and lime zest. Mid palate showcases the juniper with hints of cinnamon and green tea. Finish is nicely dry and floral with distinct notes of jasmine and lavender.

## SPRING44 MOUNTAIN GIN

Appearance: Clean clarity with a light reflecting brilliance.

**Aroma:** Crisp notes of pine and citrus. Subtle hints of malt, chocolate and earth after rainfall.

**Palate:** Delightfully dry with juniper on the front palate. Mid palate showcases coriander and ginger with hints of lime and orange zest. Finish is dry and refreshingly bold with distinct notes of mint.



## SPRING44 OLD TOM GIN

Appearance: A rich, barrel aged warm tan.

Aroma: Juniper up front with a background of light ginger and vanilla tones.

**Palate:** Nice juniper presence that is perfectly complemented with light citrus notes and hints of toasted spice. It finishes long and rounds out nicely with a touch of butterscotch sweetness.

Old Tom Gin is a classic barrel aged gin that dates back to the 18th century.

The name "Old Tom" originates from black cat-shaped plaques in public walkways in 18<sup>th</sup> century England. After depositing a penny in the cat's mouth, customers were served a shot of gin. 2021 – Bartender Spirits Award – #23 of top 50 spirits in the US
